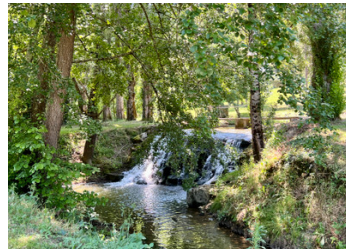

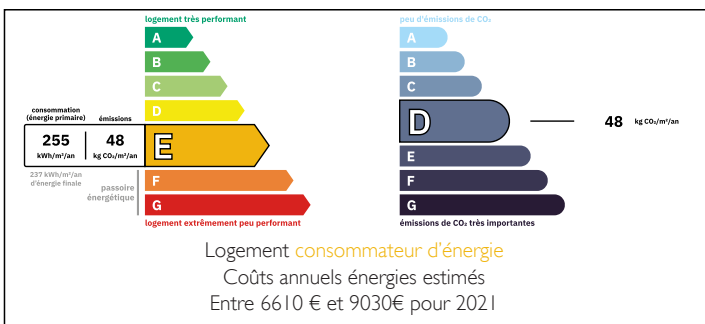

Beyond electric gates, this enchanting riverside estate offers complete privacy, where kingfishers, herons and deer thrive in unspoilt natural surroundings. At its heart lies a superb 1-hectare fishing lake, stocked with fish and complete with a fully equipped fisherman's cottage. Meadows, woodland and extensive poplar plantations, some ready for harvesting, complete this remarkable estate. Beautifully restored, the mill blends timeless character with modern comfort, offering elegant reception rooms, a kitchen/breakfast room, seven bedrooms, three bathrooms and a stunning living room with glazed floor panels revealing the river beneath the original sluice gates. A 90m riverside terrace with mosaic-tiled Jacuzzi overlooks the water. Just 10 minutes from Eymet and Issigeac, and 15 minutes from Bergerac International Airport. Private viewings by appointment.
