This remarkable chalet gained international recognition after being named by The Guardian as one of the most romantic places to stay in Europe. Bursting with character and individuality, it evokes the atmosphere of a storybook mountain hideaway, making it unlike almost anything else available in the Tarentaise Valley.

The chalet offers approximately 22 m² of habitable space split over two floors, thoughtfully arranged to maximise comfort and character.

The entrance level comprises a welcoming kitchen and dining area, together with a bathroom featuring both a bath and separate shower.

Upstairs, a cosy sitting room centred around a traditional wood-burning stove creates the perfect space to relax after a day in the mountains.

The chalet also contains two mezzanine areas (one leading off of the ground floor & a second above the lounge) This gives an additional 14.8 m² of floor space which is currently being used to comfortably sleep four people.

Outside, the chalet benefits from its own private terrace, an idyllic spot to enjoy the spectacular panoramic mountain views and the peaceful surroundings.

The hamlet is renowned for its traditional architecture, peaceful setting and exceptional sunshine, with its south-west-facing position offering breathtaking mountain views throughout the year.
