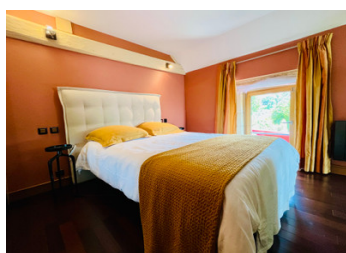
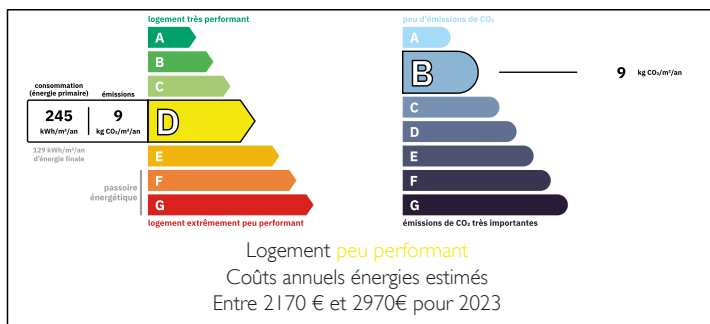


Beautiful renovated Normandy stone cottage with outbuilding, pond & 2,000 m garden

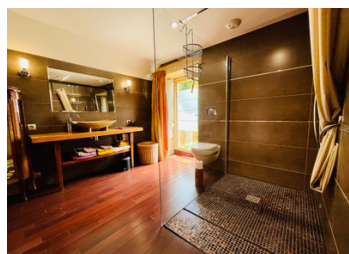

Currently operated as a successful holiday cottage, it would equally suit a permanent residence or an idyllic second home.

DESCRIPTION

Located just a short drive from the charming market town of Saint-Pierre-sur-Dives, this attractive stone cottage has been thoughtfully renovated throughout, combining authentic Norman character with modern comfort.

A flint-paved courtyard provides convenient parking beside the house, while the south-east facing exotic hardwood terrace enjoys complete privacy and lovely views over the mature gardens and ornamental pond, shaded by a magnificent weeping willow.

Originally an agricultural outbuilding, the property has been transformed into a comfortable and welcoming home of approximately 100 m².

GROUND FLOOR:

- Open-plan fitted kitchen with central island and dining area (18 m²)
- Living room with original Augeron fireplace (17 m²)
- Heated conservatory (17.5 m²) opening onto the terrace and garden
- Shower room with WC
- Utility area

FIRST FLOOR:

Landing leading to:

- Master bedroom with en-suite shower room (walk-in shower, basin and WC)
- Second double bedroom (14 m²)

The spacious attic extends over the entire house and offers exciting potential for additional accommodation, subject to the necessary permissions.
