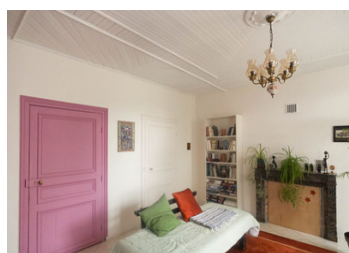
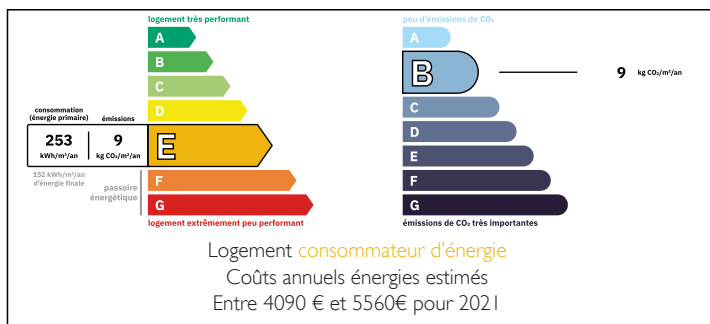


Charming property in Brittany • Two houses • Barn • Garden • 20 minutes from Saint-Brieuc

IN BRIEF

Just 20 minutes from Saint-Brieuc, in the heart of a Breton village, this property with its beautiful stone façades comprises two houses, seven bedrooms, gardens, a south-facing terrace and a separate barn.

Both houses offer comfortable and light-filled interiors, generous living spaces and a layout that allows everyone to maintain their independence. The first has four bedrooms, including two en-suite bedrooms; the second has three bedrooms and a living area opening onto the terrace. An additional space with a separate entrance directly onto the street further enhances the property's potential.

This layout is particularly well-suited to a large family, a multi-generational living arrangement, holiday cottages, guest rooms, holiday rentals or a business venture, offering the opportunity to combine a home with a hospitality business within a single property.

DESCRIPTION

Two houses combined within a single property.

The property is centred around two stone houses, each offering spacious rooms, plenty of natural light and areas suitable for living, entertaining or working in comfort.

Their layout lends itself to a variety of lifestyles: bringing a large family together, accommodating several generations whilst maintaining everyone's privacy, having a house for entertaining, or combining a main residence with a rental property.

The first house: four bedrooms and generous spaces.

The first house covers approximately 172 m² and enjoys a south-facing aspect. Its large windows flood the rooms with beautiful natural light.

The spacious central hall leads to two living rooms. One features a remarkable period ceiling and an old open-hearth fireplace, which is no longer in use but has been preserved as a decorative feature, several storage compartments. The second living room offers a cosy space centred around a wood-pellet stove.

The fitted and equipped kitchen includes a pantry. A separate toilet completes the ground floor.

On the first floor, there are two large bedrooms, each with its own en-suite shower room. A walk-in wardrobe, a utility room with a washbasin, a separate toilet and complete this level.

The top floor comprises two further bedrooms, a bathroom with a bath and a separate toilet. Electric radiators supplement the heating on these floors.
