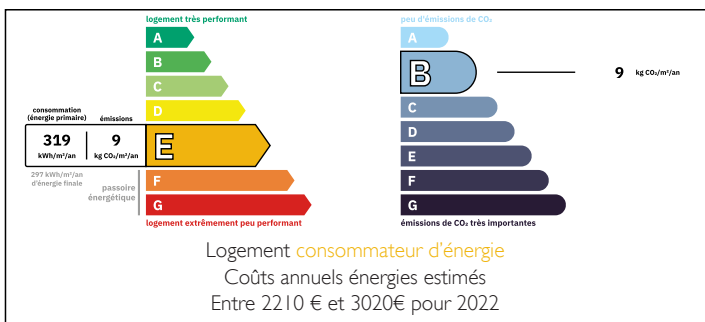

DESCRIPTION

Landing 7.40 m², wooden staircase, a lovely 8 m² attic with a small window, originally used as a bedroom. Access to the basement from both inside and outside. Cellar, 33.30 m², with a rammed earth floor and a period bread oven in perfect working order, plus one window. Storage cellar, 14 m², with a large solid wood (poplar) jam cupboard and a small window for ventilation. The roof is in excellent condition, covered with traditional slate tiles and re-laid in the traditional manner some twenty years ago. The walls are 80 cm thick, ideal for keeping out both heat waves and the cold. Outside, there is a two-storey garage, 62 m² per storey, built of stone with...
