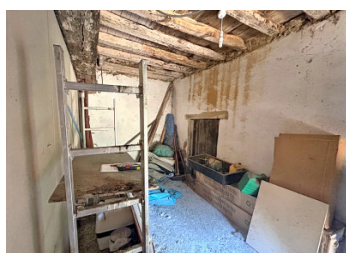
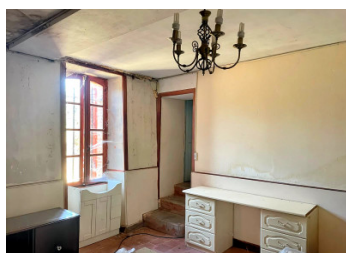


Fabulous property to renovate in the heart of the Mayenne countryside.

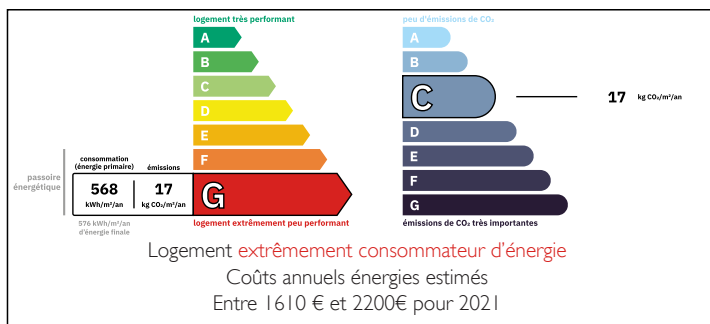

IN BRIEF

Nestled in the heart of the countryside, this charming stone house offers an exciting opportunity to create a wonderful rural home. DESCRIPTION

The front door opens into a spacious living room featuring an original red tiled floor and an attractive stone fireplace. A doorway to the left leads into a kitchen area, while a short flight of steps descends from the living room into a second reception room, also retaining its original red tiled flooring. Beyond this room is a hallway with a second entrance opening directly onto the garden.

Above, a generous loft space illuminated by two charming windows offers excellent potential for conversion into several bedrooms, subject to the necessary permissions.

Attached to the house are several traditional stone outbuildings, one of which is currently used as a woodshed, providing useful storage or further scope for development.

LOCAL TAXES

Taxe foncière: 316 EUR

Just a few metres from the house stands a substantial stone barn for renovation, ideal for a workshop, additional accommodation (subject to planning), or a variety of other uses.

Surrounded by rolling countryside, the property offers peace and privacy while remaining conveniently located. The historic town of Évron, renowned for its impressive abbey church, is only a short drive away, while the city of Laval provides a full range of amenities together with direct TGV rail services to Paris and Charles de Gaulle Airport
