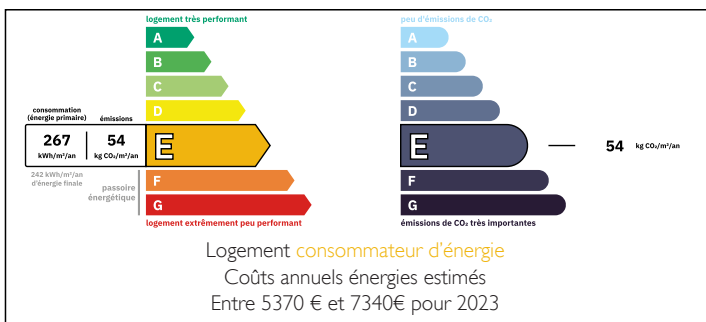

DESCRIPTION

Peaceful, private and full of character, this beautifully renovated period home enjoys an idyllic setting within mature gardens, complete with a charming stone barn offering endless possibilities for entertaining, hobbies or future projects. An ideal family home or countryside retreat, it is perfectly placed for enjoying the tranquillity of rural Anjou while remaining within easy reach of Angers and the Loire Valley's many attractions.

The entrance opens into an impressive dining room with a vaulted ceiling and original bread ovens, creating a wonderful focal point. The fitted kitchen enjoys direct access to the rear terrace and is complemented by a practical back kitchen and laundry room as well as the boiler room.

The ground floor also offers a choice of reception rooms: a sitting room with fireplace and marble floor, a cosy lounge with a wood-burning stove, a sauna with adjoining shower room, a separate WC, and a further reception room with access to the cellar that could easily be adapted as a ground-floor bedroom if required.

Upstairs, the landing leads to a spacious principal bedroom with small dressing room, a family bathroom with spa bath and WC, a second bedroom with a walk-in wardrobe, and a third bedroom currently used as a home office.

Outside, the established gardens provide interest throughout the seasons, with sweeping lawns, magnificent oak, walnut, ginkgo and chestnut trees, mature roses and hydrangeas, fruit trees, a productive vegetable garden, a naturally fed pond, a small paddock and a traditional well with pump. A...

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
