What's near?

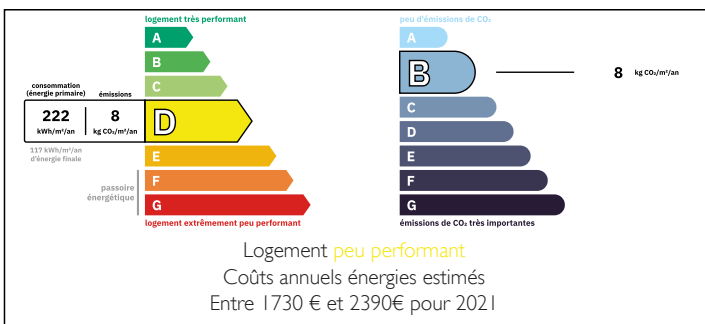

The property itself has a large, welcoming kitchen. The lounge/dining area has double aspect windows and is flooded with natural light. Through from the kitchen is a downstairs WC plus small laundry area. Stairs lead to a useful office and two large bedrooms both full of natural light. The bathroom has a bath, WC, sink and heated towel rail. There are electric radiators and in the main bedroom a heat source pump provides heat and air conditioning in the main bedroom.

Opposite the house is a large garage/workshop with an old bread oven. The rear of this building leads to a piece of land also included in the sale.

For those wanting to escape from busy lives, a few steps from the house there is a large garden. The current owners have enjoyed sitting in the summer house, immersing themselves in nature. This elevated position offers stunning views across the countryside. There are fruit trees here and space for a large vegetable plot. The perfect place to sit and connect with nature, listening to the birds. A short walk from a river this really is a nature lovers paradise.
