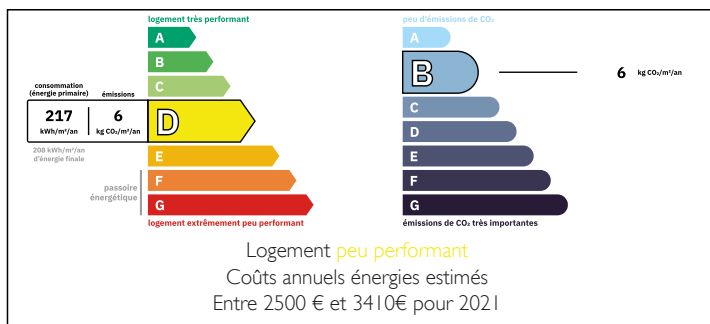
This beautiful stone country house with spacious extension offers panoramic views over the countryside of Champéon. In the peace and quiet yet walking distance from the centre of the village.

As well as the open plan kitchen, dining room, living room and four bedrooms, there is a gite renovation project in progress.

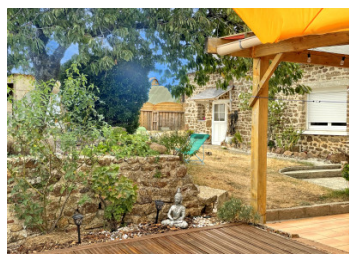

DESCRIPTION

Entering the house from the terrace you arrive in a spacious open plan kitchen and dining area recently renovated with ample storage and work space. The dining room leads you into the living room (31,6m²) with its fireplace and stairs to the bedrooms and bathroom. From the living room there is another door taking you into the garden and swimming pool area which is nicely boarded with decking.

Upstairs two bedrooms (13,34m² and 14m²) with large windows enjoy views of the swimming pool and the surrounding countryside. A third room (9,2m²) currently used as a study overlooks the countryside at the rear of the house and at the end of the corridor there is another bedroom (12,5m²) which faces the carpark.

There is a large bathroom with two sinks, a toilet, a bath and a shower. There is also a downstairs toilet.

There is a gite which has been partly renovated with a new door and double glazed windows. It has also been partly insulated. On the ground floor of the gite the front door opens into the main room (23m²). From here there are stairs leading to two rooms (13m² and 7,8m²).

On the ground floor of the extended area there is a room harbouring the washing machine and the pellet fuel boiler. Next to this there is a garage (20m²) and a cave (11,4m²). There is also a second garage separate to house which is currently used as a workshop (16,7m²).
