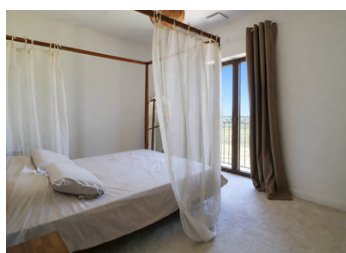
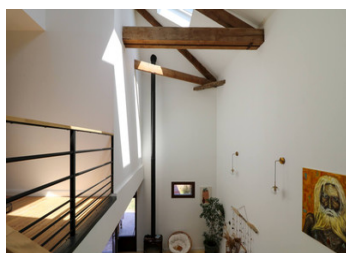

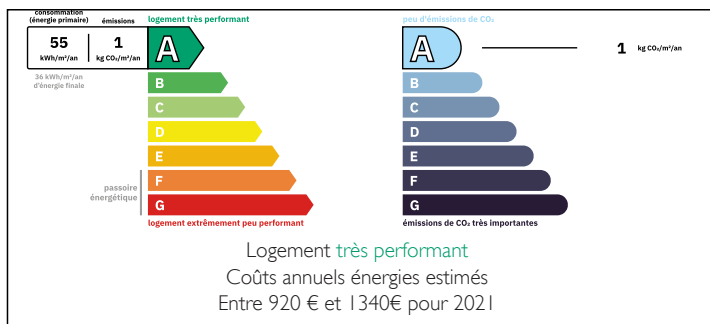

DESCRIPTION

This beautifully built and bright home in Canaules-et-Argentières enjoys a peaceful setting among open fields, with only a few neighbouring properties and wide views towards the foothills of the Cévennes.

On the ground floor, the heart of the house is a large open-plan living space with a wood-burning stove and a striking kitchen arranged around a central island – creating a natural place for cooking, conversation and time together. Large openings bring in plenty of light and connect the room directly with the terrace. The additional room adjoining the main living area can be used as a guest bedroom, home office or storage room. On this floor you will also find a storage room and a toilet.

On the first floor you will find three spacious bedrooms, and one master bedroom with en-suite bathroom and walk-in closet. On this floor there is one well-finished bathroom more, together with generous built-in storage and a toilet. The same high standard of craftsmanship and materials continues throughout this level.

Outside, the terrace includes a pizza oven and overlooks the surrounding countryside. The garden also features a private plunge pool, ideal for cooling off on warm summer days.

A particularly well-finished property combining traditional character, modern comfort, light-filled interiors and an exceptionally peaceful setting. The house is ready to move into as it stands.

Daily amenities and a weekly Sunday market can be found in Lézan, around 4 km away, while the medieval village of Sauve, officially classified as a 'Village de Caractère',...
